



Purpose of Hearing

 To accept public comment on a major diversion of parkland that is under consideration.


 Proposed diversion relates to the construction of a new Linwood Well at Maple, Graydon Parks



Description of Diversion


- Construct a new Linwood Well. Connect the new well to the existing well house.
- Lands Affected:
 - Block 3209, Lot 1
 (Maple Park): ~0.01 ac
 of 12.42 ac will be
 diverted
 - Block 3209, Lot 3: (Graydon Park): ~0.02 ac of 7.97 ac will be diverted
- Diversion(s)
 - Major (new well) (100 sf)
 - Minor (subsurface easement) (1,366 SF)





Description of Diversion


- Administrative
 Consent Order
 requires new Linwood
 Well and includes
 timelines for
 implementation.
- New well needs to be constructed next to the existing wellhouse, resulting in the contemplated diversion.
- Existing wellhouse dates back to 1930s.




Public Need/Benefit
