You may have noticed that we, and in certain cases some of your neighbors, have increased our conservation messaging as we entered this year's peak demand season.

After a very dry May and June, our water system was on track to have one of the highest peak demand seasons in almost a decade. We are excited to announce that this July is looking to be one of the lowest peak season water use months in a long time. So thank you all for your efforts to reduce the use and in helping us by both conserving water and getting this important message out!

**Thanks to you we have been able to avoid Stage III, or IV Water Restrictions and have still been able to stick to our PFAS Operational Strategy, shutting down wells with the highest levels of PFAS contamination until we complete the construction on our PFAS Treatment Facilities.**

- Odd-numbered addresses may irrigate on Tuesdays and Saturdays
- Even-numbered addresses may irrigate on Wednesdays and Sundays
- Governmental properties may irrigate on Mondays and Fridays
