## **Be Water Wise!**

Did you know that water use *triples* during the summer due to irrigation? One of the most effective ways to reduce outdoor water use is following the mandatory two-day-per-week watering schedule below. Cutting back on the amount of time you water your yard also makes a big difference. Shaving just five minutes off your watering schedule can save up to 15 gallons!

### Mandatory Two-Day-Per-Week Watering Schedule

| Address Type       | Day of the Week         | Irrigation Type            | Time of Day                   |
|--------------------|-------------------------|----------------------------|-------------------------------|
| Odd Number         | Tuesday and<br>Saturday | Manual Irrigation          | Before 10 am or<br>after 6 pm |
| Even Number        | Wednesday and<br>Sunday | Automatic Irrigation       | Between 3 am<br>and 7 am      |
| Municipal Property | Monday and Friday       | Smart Controller<br>Permit | Between 3 am<br>and 7 am      |

Irrigation is allowed any day within time restrictions noted above if using a hand-held hose or drip irrigation. Smart Controller Permits can be obtained from Ridgewood Water.
