Times to Water Lawns

- Manual Lawn Sprinklers:** ● Before 10 am or After 6 pm
- Auto Irrigation Systems including Smart Controller Permit Holders:** ● Between 3 am and 7 am

PFAS Treatment Facility Updates

Ridgewood Water has reached another milestone! The Village of Ridgewood Council awarded the construction contract for the East Ridgewood and West End PFAS Treatment Facilities to Sovereign Consulting, Inc. Construction is planned to begin in summer/fall 2024, pending final review by the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank.

East Ridgewood and West End are the 6th and 7th treatment facilities to be awarded out of the 12 proposed in our PFAS Treatment Master Plan. They are expected to be online by February 2026.
