In accordance with procedures established to evaluate projects that have applied for assistance under the New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Financing Program (EIFP), a Level 1 environmental review has been conducted on the proposed project, which will involve construction of a new 1,333 sq ft drinking water treatment facility to remove PFAS contaminants mandated by the NJDEP. The proposed treatment facility is within the existing property boundary of Ridgewood Water's Southside Reservoir and Pump Station located at the end of De Boer Drive at Hwy 208, Block 187 of Lot 2, Glen Rock, NJ 07452.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has made a preliminary decision to assist this project under the EIFP. The proposed project costs are as follows:
