



For construction of raw water mains to provide centralized PFAS treatment to the Ridgewood Water System, the projects are financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB) in the following amounts:

- Raw Water Mains Phase 1 – Contract 1 (Glen Rock and Ridgewood, NJ) - \$2,603,250
- Raw Water Mains Phase 1 – Contract 2 (Midland Park and Wyckoff, NJ) - \$673,938
- Raw Water Mains Phase 1 – Contract 3 (Midland Park, Ridgewood and Wyckoff, NJ) - \$7,477,971.58
- Raw Water Mains Phase 1 – Contract 4 (Wyckoff, NJ) - \$4,783,933.04

The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (NJIB) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the NJIB to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

These projects will improve water quality for the residents and businesses in the Ridgewood Water System (Glen Rock, Midland Park, Ridgewood, and Wyckoff, NJ) by connecting Ridgewood Water facilities to centralized PFAS treatment facilities to comply with the drinking water standards set by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
