



Provision of Lead Service Line Replacements for Ridgewood Water's Service Area was financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB) for the following project:

- LSL Replacements Contract 1 (2025-2026) - \$3,253,650

The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

This project will improve water quality for the residents and businesses in the Ridgewood Water System (Glen Rock, Midland Park, Ridgewood, and Wyckoff, NJ) by removing lead and galvanized service lines and replacing them with new copper service lines to comply with the Lead and Copper Rule set by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. Contract 1 will complete LSL Replacements at approximately 500 property addresses.

State Revolving Fund programs around the nation provide states and communities the resources necessary to maintain and improve the infrastructure protecting our valuable water resources nationwide.
